You may know Martyn as the Presenter on Mercury FM, Talk Radio UK or one of the BBC local stations. He started broadcasting professionally 30 years ago. Not limiting himself to just on-air activities Martyn was soon to be found, during the 80's organising outside broadcasts, concerts and roadshows as promotions manager for Radio Mercury.

During this time he also organised car launches, fun days, product sampling and events for, Sainsbury's, British Rail, Cadburys, Coca-Cola Findus & others. For over 15 years he was the driving force behind "The Rock & Roll Ball". The Ball rose over £500,000 for the Cancer Research UK.

The business of entertaining big crowds is nothing new to Martyn. At the very start of his career he regularly helped 2,000 people to have a wild Saturday night when he was the star DJ at the world famous Hammersmith Palais in London. "Life was just one long party!" he remembers.

In the 1990's yet another ambition was achieved when Martyn appeared in panto, Cinderella followed a year later by Aladdin, both at the Thorndike, Leatherhead for Bill kenwright.

Christmas 1995 was to see a return to the stage as King of Gooseland in Mother Goose at the Horsham Arts Centre.

In 1998 Martyn was asked to project manage the "Thresher Drinks Party" at Battersea Park, London by international agency Project Worldwide. In 2003 he started his own agency with colleagues: Goose Live Events now includes AstraZeneca, Bentley, Costa, Lamborghini, Mondi, Royal Automobile Club Veteran Car Run, Syngenta & Unilever amongst its clients. Not to mention Gooses own event the Silverstone Classic, The World's Biggest Classic Motor Racing Festival.

Martyn can still be heard on the radio as he continues to present programmes for local radio in his spare time at both BBC and independent stations in the South East.
